## Categories and Level Classification

The tournament is divided into three categories according to the playing level of the participants: A, B, and C.

### Category A

**Bezirksoberliga level and above.**

For doubles events, we recommend that each doubles pair should include at least one Chinese player whenever possible. This is a suggestion, not a mandatory requirement.

### Category B

**Bezirksklasse A to Bezirksliga level.**

### Category C

**Bezirksklasse B level and below.**

For players who participate in league competitions, the category will generally be determined based on the team and league level in which the player was registered during the 2025/2026 season. If a player has already regularly represented a higher-level team during the first half of the season, the player may be classified according to that higher-level team and the corresponding league level.

In doubles events, the category of a pair will generally be determined by the player with the higher level. If intentional registration in a lower category is discovered, the organizing committee reserves the right to cancel all match results of the player or pair concerned, and the registration fee will not be refunded.

In addition, if U18 players participate, they must also be classified strictly according to the corresponding O18 level. For example, if a 16-year-old male singles player competes in U18 Bezirksoberliga, he must register for Category A, corresponding to Bezirksoberliga level, in this tournament.

The organizing committee reserves the right to adjust the category of participants based on the registration situation, the actual level of the players, and considerations of fairness.

## Tournament Format

The tournament format is as follows:

Each game is played to 15 points. Matches are played as best of three games, with a maximum score of 21 points per game.

The tournament will begin with a group stage in a round-robin format. After the group stage, a knockout stage will be played in a single-elimination format.

The exact schedule, qualification rules, and knockout-stage arrangements will be decided by the organizing committee based on the actual number of registrations in each event and will be announced on site.

Women's Doubles and Women's Singles in each category may be adjusted separately depending on the actual number of registrations.

## Eligibility

This tournament is open to badminton enthusiasts, club players, and league players who meet the level requirements of the corresponding category.

Players who do not participate in league competitions or do not have an official team registration record may also register. The organizing committee will assign categories based on their actual playing level, registration information, and considerations of fairness.

For minors participating in the tournament, responsibility for participation lies with their legal guardians.

If there are additional requirements regarding age, association registration, or club membership, the final notice issued by the organizing committee shall apply.

## Important Notice: Participant Limit

This tournament may be subject to a strict limit on the number of participants. Players are therefore advised to complete their registration as early as possible once registration opens.

If an event or category reaches its participant limit, confirmations will be made according to the order of registration, following a "first come, first served" principle until all available spots are filled.

## Registration Fee

The registration fee is €10 per person per event, payable in cash on site.

## Draws

The draw for each event will generally be conducted approximately 15 minutes before the start of that event, based on the players who have arrived and completed check-in.

Players must complete check-in within the designated time period. If a player fails to check in on time, the organizing committee reserves the right to adjust their eligibility or match arrangements according to the situation on site.

## Prizes and Award Ceremony

The top three players or pairs in each category and event will receive prizes or awards.

Currently confirmed prizes:

Category A Champion:

Each player receives a trophy, certificate, and €50 cash prize.

Category A Runner-up and Third Place:

Each player receives a medal, certificate, and prize.

Category B Champion:

Each player receives a trophy, certificate, and €30 cash prize.

Category B Runner-up and Third Place:

Each player receives a medal, certificate, and prize.

Category C Champion:

Each player receives a medal and certificate.

Category C Runner-up and Third Place:

Each player receives a certificate.

## Shuttles

In principle, the tournament will use shuttles that meet the requirements of the current competition season.

Participants or pairs are responsible for preparing their own shuttles for matches.

If shuttles are available for purchase on site, they may be bought on the tournament day. Details are subject to the on-site arrangements.

In addition, a paid racket stringing service will be available courtside at the venue.

## Tournament Rules and Minimum Number of Entries

The tournament will be conducted according to generally applicable badminton competition rules.

Where applicable, the official rules of the DBV, the German Badminton Association, and the competition regulations of the BBV, the Bavarian Badminton Association, may be used as references.

Whether a particular event or category will be held depends on the actual number of registrations. In principle, an event or category will only be held if the minimum required number of entries is reached.

## General Information

The organizing committee may make necessary adjustments to the tournament arrangements, categories, format, schedule, and court allocation based on the actual situation on the tournament day.

If any adjustments are made, the organizing committee will inform the participants before the start of the tournament or during the tournament. We thank all participants for their understanding and cooperation.

By registering, participants are deemed to participate in the tournament voluntarily and to assume the corresponding risks and responsibilities associated with participation. For minors, responsibility lies with their legal guardians.

By registering, participants are deemed to have understood and agreed to comply with the tournament rules, on-site arrangements, and relevant instructions issued by the organizing committee.

The organizing committee and co-organizers shall not be liable for injuries, losses, or damages caused by personal reasons, accidents, or other unforeseeable circumstances.

## Venue Rules

Outdoor shoes are not permitted in the sports area of the venue.

Smoking is prohibited inside the venue.

During the tournament, drinks and simple food will be available for purchase on site. Details are subject to the actual arrangements at the venue.

## Data Protection and Use of Photos and Videos

By registering, participants are deemed to consent to the organizing committee storing and processing their necessary personal information for the purposes of tournament organization, scheduling, communication, and result management.

By registering, participants are also deemed to consent that photos and videos taken during the tournament, in which they may be identifiable, may be used for tournament reports, official websites, social media, and printed promotional materials.

If participants have any special requests regarding this matter, they should contact the organizing committee at the time of registration or before the start of the tournament.
